Instructions to Load Human Resources Database

Download the HumanResourcesDatabaseInsertStatements.zip file from the official text book website, <https://sqlstudents.com/>. After clicking on the download link found on the site, a window like the one shown below will pop-up and to confirm the downloading of the file.

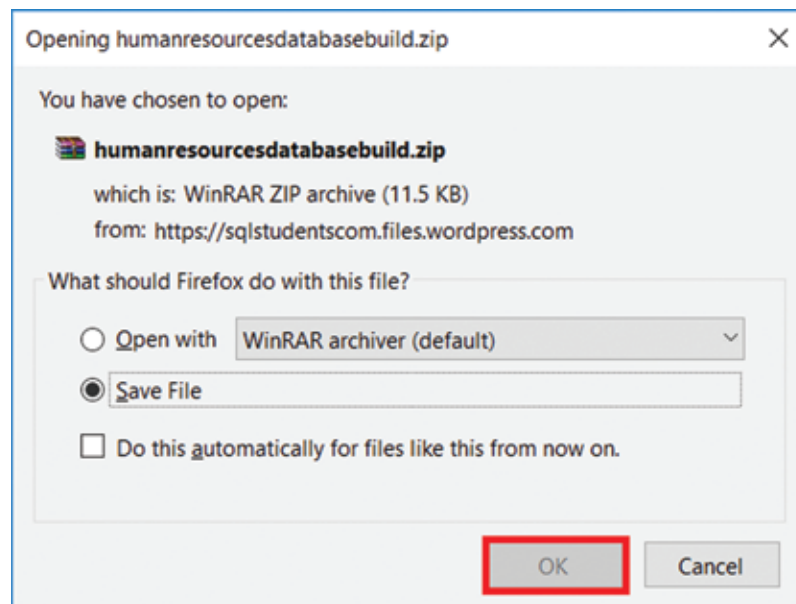

After saving the file, navigate to the location where it was saved. Unless you changed the destination, the file should have downloaded to the “Downloads” folder by default.

Right click on the zip file and extract the file to the location of your preference as shown in Figure 2. As you can see, I created a folder called “SQL_Students” and I’m using that location for the download.

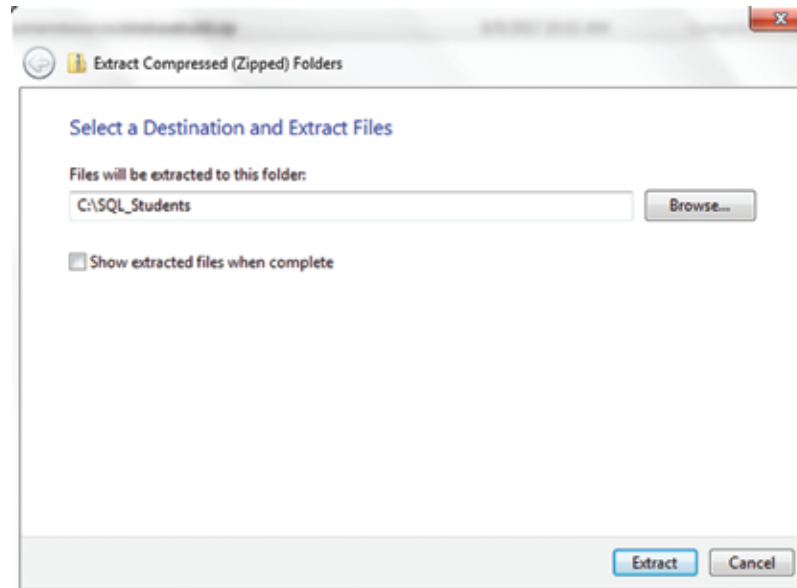

The result is a file called HumanResourcesDatabasebuild.sql as seen in Figure 3.

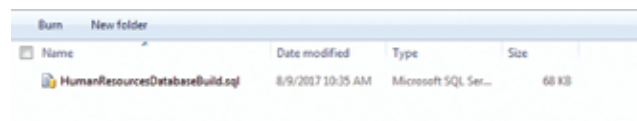

Next launch SQL Server and simply click ‘Connect’. (If you encounter any errors refer to Chapter 2)

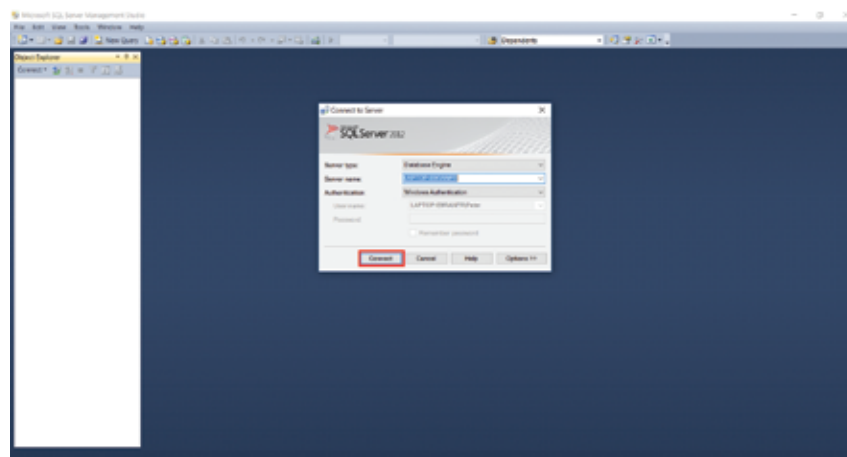

Once SQL successful launches > Navigate to the File tab > Open > File...

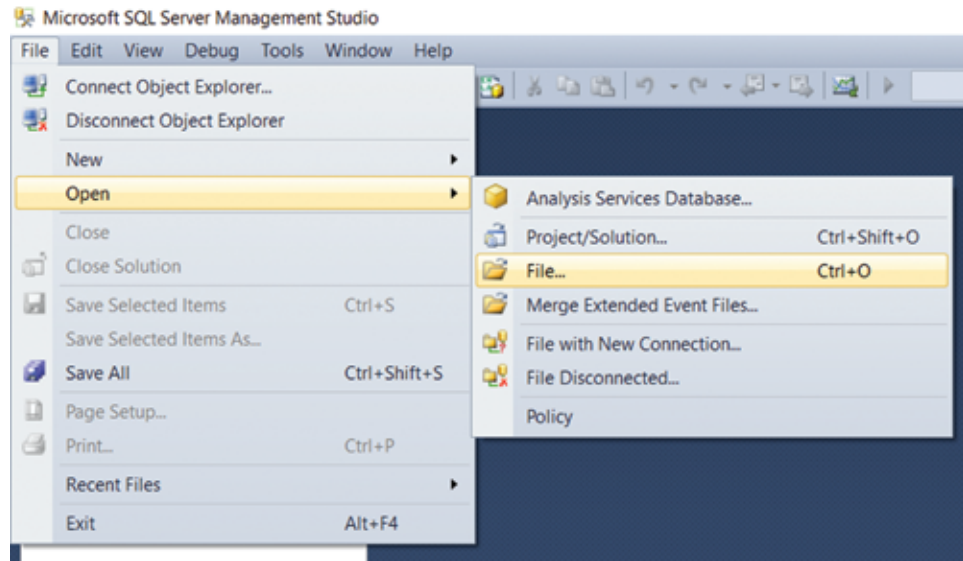

Next navigate to where you saved the HumanResourcesDatabasebuild.sql file and click on it.

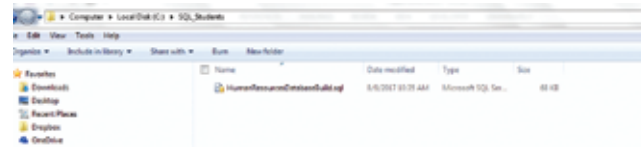

The file will open in SQL Server. Next Point to the “Execute” button (see red circle below) on the tool bar and press it to execute the statements shown in Figure 7.

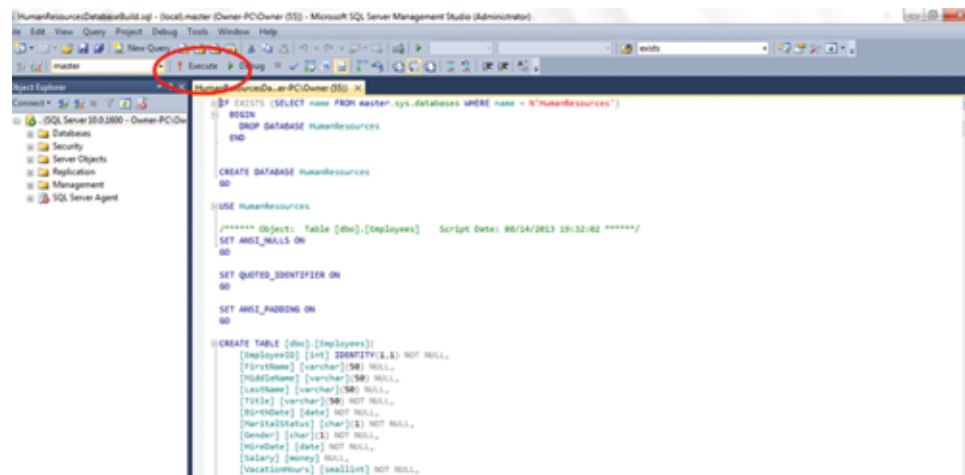

As it executes you will see the message “Executing query” as shown circled in Figure 8.

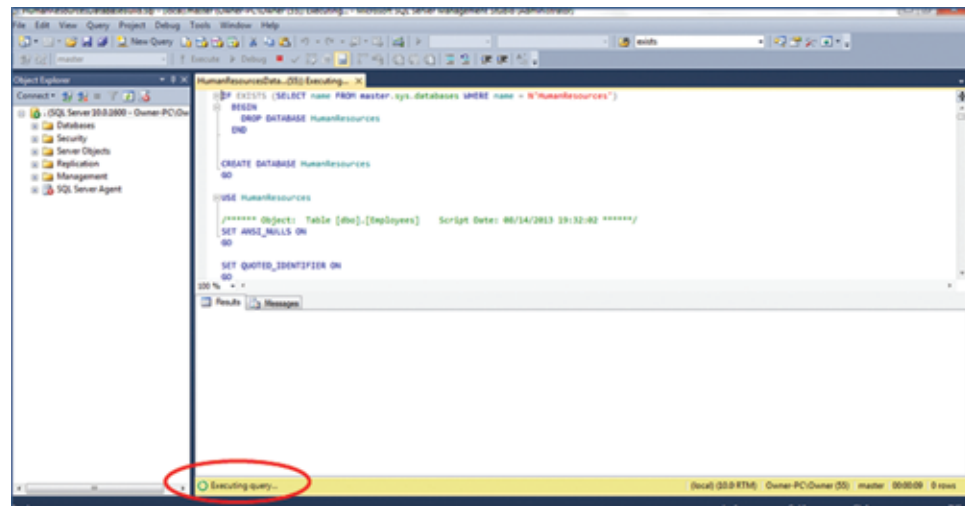

Once it finishes executing close the file and open the folder called “Databases” on the Object Explorer on the left and you will see your HumanResources database as shown in Figure 9.

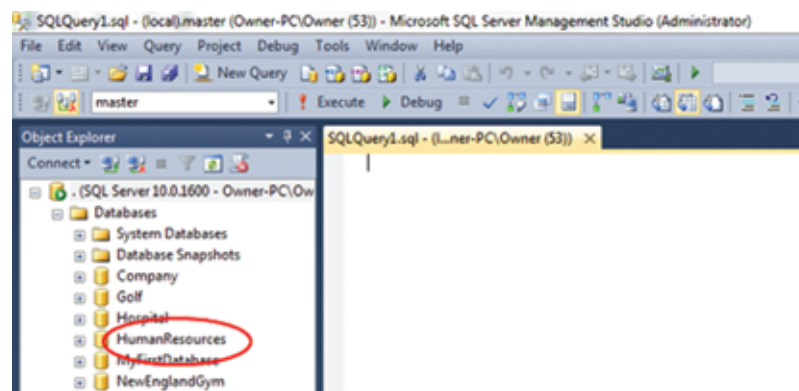
